To relax after a long day of skiing, enjoy a visit to Oravice - outdoor geothermal water pools, the largest Aquapark in Slovakia with various water attractions such as water jets, water mushroom, water bowl, underwater benches and more.

#### DAY 1 - Welcome to Bratislava

Welcome at the airport, pick followed by meeting with your tour guide and start of the tour of Bratislava – the capital city, visiting attractions such as:

Primate's Palace – a marvelous Classicist and largest palace in Bratislava where the Treaty of Pressburg was signed in 1805
St. Martin's Cathedral - one of the largest gothic constructions in Bratislava where the coronations of 19 rulers took place between 1563-1830, including Austro-Hungarian empress Maria Theresa

Michael's gate - the only preserved city gate, ranking among the oldest town buildings historical narrow streets, squares, Slovak National Theatre and of course the historic Bratislava castle.

During the tour we will stop for a lunch in the city centre.

Afternoon - transfer to Jasna (apx. 3hr drive) Dinner & overnight in Rohace





DAY 2 - 6 - Skiing at Rohace - West Tatras,

You can combine your trip with these extra tours:

- **1. Skansen Zuberec** The Museum of the Orava Village (Slovak: Múzeum oravskej dediny). This open air museum of folk architecture xhibits intact rural houses brought from all around the region of Orava and re-assembled in Zuberec. The gardens and fields around the houses show various ancient forms of farming and animal husbandry
- 2. Orava castle Orava castle s situated on a high rock above Orava river. It is considered to be one of the most beautiful castles in Slovakia. The castle was built in the thirteenth century. Many scenes of the 1922 film Nosferatu were filmed here, although until recently it was thought to have been shot in Transylvania. Orava Castle stands on the site of an old wooden fortification, built after the Tartar invasion of 1241. Its history since then reveals a familiar pattern of construction, destruction, reconstruction, fire, various ownerships and territorial squabbles. The original design was in Romanesque and Gothic style; it was later reconstructed as a Renaissance and Neo-Gothic structure, hugging the shape of the 520-metre spur on which it.
- 3. Welness Oravice THERMAL ORAVICE lies within the Orava region Western Mountains, near the border with Poland, only few kilometers from Zakopane. From the depth of 1611 m of natural thermal water springs with the beneficial effect of temperature 58 ° C, which flows into all the pools in the area of Thermal ORAVICE on 1545 m2 area. Thermal water is highly mineralized sodium calcium magnesium sulphurous high iron content. Direct access from the building and allows the pools to bathe in all weathers and all seasons.
